Hydraulic fracturing's call for water management solutions has been kickstarted by a resurgence of drilling activity in 2017 and pressure on companies to rein in operating costs. Bluefield's basin-by-basin forecast for water management, which surpasses US\$136 billion over the next decade, highlights the emergence of new inputs that are influencing energy players' water and wastewater strategies and associated costs.

An inventory of more than 83,000 completed horizontal wells have required supply, transport, treatment, and disposal for more than 350 billion gallons of water since 2011. While significant in scale, water volumes per frack are rising steadily to as much as 12 million gallons per well in select basins.

Unquestionably, a sub-US\$50 per barrel of oil market environment has laid waste to hundreds of energy service companies, many of which are now in bankruptcy. The upside of this shakeout, however, has been a more concerted effort by surviving companies to focus on cost cutting and operational efficiencies, including a focus on alternative water supply and recycling in Pennsylvania, Texas.
