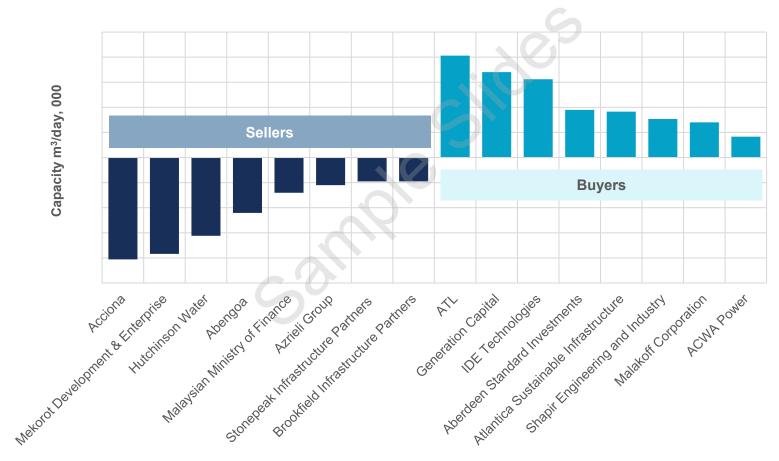
## **Biggest Movers & Shakers, 2016–2022**

Since 2016, more than X million m<sup>3</sup>/day have been divested, led by Acciona's divestment of ATL in the wake of disputes.

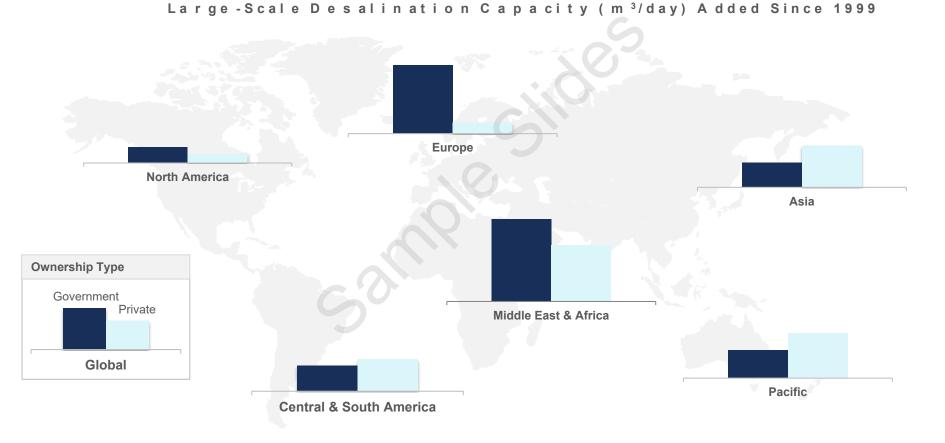


## Largest Cumulative Net Gains and Losses from 2016 to 2022

## Total Capacity Additions by Region, 1999–2022

Global desalination capacity is shaped by baseload demand markets (e.g., Middle East-North Africa) and peaking markets like North America and Australia facing volatility in water supply availability. Since 1999, over X million m<sup>3</sup>/d of large-scale plant capacity (>50,000 m<sup>3</sup>/d) has been added across the globe.
